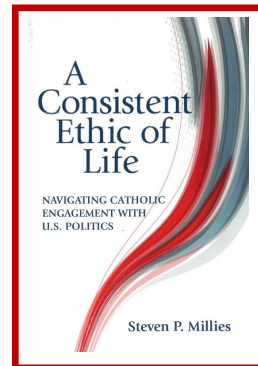
Trying to navigate the turbulence of U.S. Politics?
