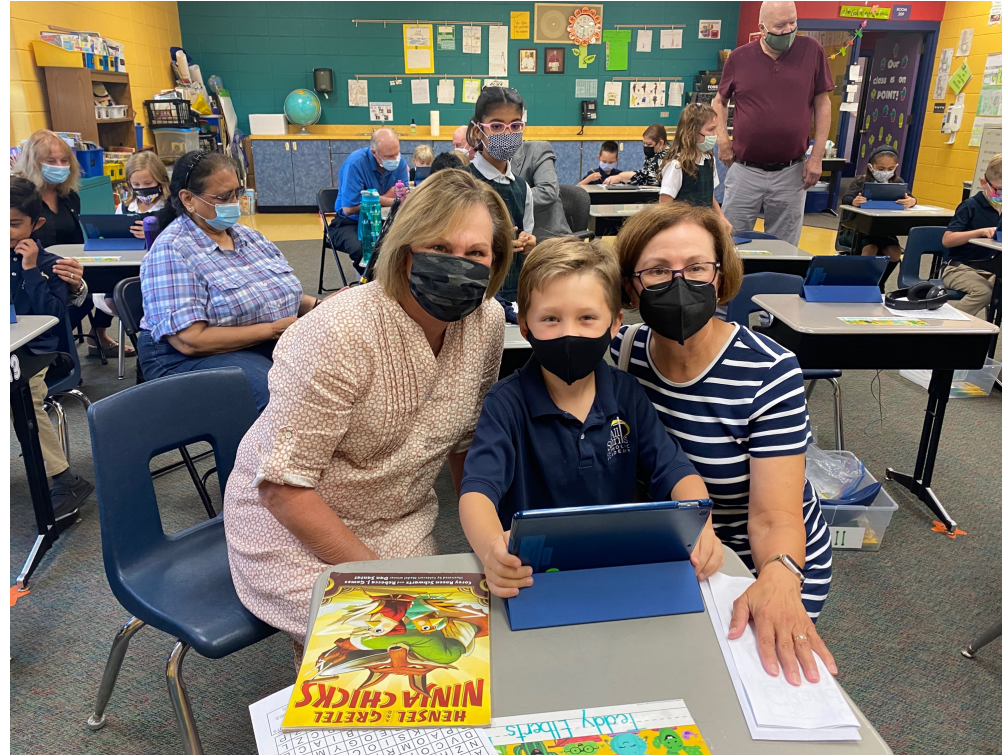
## WHAT
