Music Advocacy

Music classes are a vital part of student academic achievement. The importance of music and fine arts has been debated in school board rooms across the country for several years.

A recent study explored the relationship of instrumental music instruction and academic achievement for the senior class of Lee County High School in Leesburg, Georgia. Significant correlations were found between the number of years of band instruction and higher academic achievement as measured by the Georgia Graduation High School Test (GGHST) Mathematics and Science exams.
