Do you shop at Jewel, stop for gas, or get coffee at Starbuck's? Do you eat at restaurants like Chili's or TGI Friday's? Ever stop for fast food at Wendy's or Chipotle? Do you have donuts on Saturday morning? Do you shop at Kohl's, JCPenney, Macy's, or TJ Maxx? What about Home Depot or Lowe's? If the answer is "yes," you should be using Scrip! The Scrip program is easy. You simply order gift cards for the places you usually shop, and you'll earn money towards your family fundraising obligation. Your family and friends can sign up and help your family earn money, too.

What is Scrip? "Scrip" is a term that means "substitute money." Basically, it's a fancy word for "gift cards." It is a very easy way to fulfill your fundraising obligation, without spending any extra money! You order a \$20 gift card, pay \$20, and receive a \$20 gift card. The Scrip company then sends us the gift cards at a discounted rate. The amount of the discount is then credited to your family. It's that easy! And once your fundraising obligation is met, don't stop ordering Scrip! You can use a portion of the amount earned in excess of the fundraising obligation towards next year's tuition.
