Why Should Your Child Join Competitive Chess Club?

Chess is an enriching activity that promotes creativity and concentration. Competitive Chess Club is an opportunity for your child to play and learn the game in a fun, friendly and educational environment. All experience levels are welcome! In addition to after school practices, there will be opportunities for students to join weekend tournaments as a team. Your child will not only learn the elements of victory, but also how to play with integrity.

Rules

Student interest is essential! Everyone must be respectful to one another, the instructor and equipment. Running or goofing around is not permitted. Children will be warned, then parents will be notified in repeat instances of poor behavior. Numerous notifications may result in withdrawal from Competitive Chess Club without refund.

Pickup

To ensure child safety positive transfer to a parent or caregiver is required. The instructor will wait with students inside door #1 for pickup. Students must be received at the door because they are not permitted to walk to the parking lot unattended. At 4:50pm remaining students will be brought to after school care.
