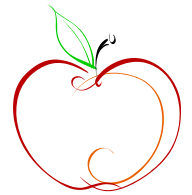

Put your backpack away, there's no school today.

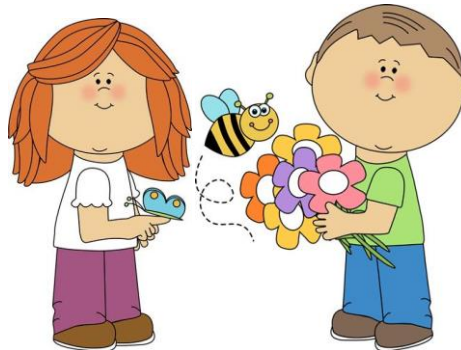
Sleep late in bed. Summer months stretch ahead!
